Does your family have a special and cherished place within your home? The heart of our home here at Holy Family Motherhouse is our Chapel. I could never begin to measure the time our Sisters and I have spent in prayer in our Chapel over these many years! But now, not only am I praying in the Chapel ... I'm praying for your help to safeguard our Chapel.

Sadly, we're dealing with a troubling (and worsening) situation.

The slate roof that has served and protected our Chapel so faithfully for more than 80 years is well past the end of its life, and fading fast. The contractor says we must replace it immediately or risk catastrophic damage to our worship space. The total cost is estimated at \$175,000.00 — a significant financial worry for us.

Friend, your past support meant so much to all of us. Would you renew your support today with a donation of your most generous offering, to help replace our Chapel roof and protect our spiritual home? I am so very grateful to the caring friends like you who made it possible for us to renovate our Chapel in 2020. Unfortunately, the issues with the roof didn't surface until after that interior work was done. And, as the contractor explained, once slate roofs begin to deteriorate, they do so quickly. *The need for a new roof is truly urgent!*

I want to assure you, we take our commitment to stewardship very seriously. We budget carefully and do our best to spend wisely. Taking on a major expense like this happens only after extensive research, collaboration with trusted partners, and a lot of discussion and reflection.

What we must now do is clear: Our Sisters and our students at the Academy of the Holy Family truly need us to preserve the worship space that knits our community together.

As you surely know from your own home, the longer you wait to make a repair, the more costly it becomes — and the more damage you incur. We need this new roof ASAP!

Our Spiritual Home for Eight Decades

Every time the snow falls during the winter here, I ask God to hold up our roof and keep our Chapel safe.

My Sisters and I cannot imagine our Motherhouse without our Chapel.

Our Chapel seats 300 people, but the space is so much bigger than that — it holds the prayers, joys, fears, tears, hopes, and promises of the Sisters and students who have worshipped there since the Chapel was built in 1941.

The Chapel is where we are officially received into the Congregation as novices. It is where we dedicate our lives to God forever in our Perpetual Vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience. It is where we gather each day as a Community at morning and evening to praise God, pray for the needs of the world, and pray for good friends like you. It is where we retreat on our own during the day to renew our spirit and open ourselves to God's love and goodness.

And it is from our Chapel that our Community sends us home to God when we come to the end of our lives.

The Danger Is Real, and the Need Is Urgent

Now, as the roof has reached its own “end of life,” as the contractor told us, our beautiful spiritual home is under serious threat. A leaky roof could cause massive damage.

- Ceilings and walls could stain, bubble, or deteriorate.
- Electrical hazards might arise if water reaches wiring, fixtures, or outlets.
- Rafters and beams could rot and weaken.
- Dangerous mold could develop, harming air quality and causing illness.

- Our pews, statues, or tabernacle could be destroyed by water damage.
- The many labors of love that went into our 2020 Chapel renovation could be undone.
